



## London 2020 Newsletter No. 12: 7 January 2020

**Literature Closed!** The closing date for applications for both paper and digital literature has now passed. The Organising Committee were very keen to make London 2020 a literature friendly exhibition – and we have been delighted with 264 exhibits! Of these, 229 are printed and 35 are digital.

For those who have already submitted applications for paper books, please remember that they should be sent to London by 1 February 2020. All National Commissioners have the addressing details, so please ask them for the details rather than the central team.

As an aside, no-one I have spoken to can recall a previous FIP Exhibition that has had more than 264 literature exhibits. Can anyone report a larger literature class from the past?

**Jury.** The selection of the jury is now complete and a list of jurors, including apprentices and those cross-accrediting, who have accepted our invitation, has been posted on the website. See [www.london2020.co/jury](http://www.london2020.co/jury) for details.
